Parish facility; - The parish council requested that the clerk contacted Paul Costiff to establish why questions were being asked so that the correct information could be obtained. It was resolved by members that no further money would be spent in relation to the building extension. Members did ask the clerk to speak to Paul Costiff to establish whether he would be willing to meet members to discuss the project.

Members asked the clerk to explore other options within the parish. Building which could be extended or buildings which could be rented.

The clerk made members aware that residents were concerned about access Parker Street in particular for emergency vehicles. It was resolved that a map of the area be reviewed with some potential access improvements to prevent cars being parked to prevent access.

Residents had also contacted the clerk in relation to double yellow lines being introduced at the entrance of Heva Road. The clerk had submitted concerns to County Cllr Shelagh McKiernan and also Staffordshire Highways.
