Clive Keen is concerned that drug dealing in the Carver Road Estate is becoming a drug. It was agreed that any registration numbers reported the local police would be useful.

306/8-3-16 County and borough councillor reports to be received

County Cllr Clarke asked the parish council if they would consider a location for a memorial garden for a resident who fort in WW1 who lived on Tutbury Road.

Borough Cllr S Andjelkovic was concerned that several groups will not be receiving funding from ESBC. Pot holes are still an issue in the parish in particular Parker Street. Parking issues are still an issue.

County Cllr McKiernan informed the parish council that in relation to the Controlled parking zone - the county are still waiting for the parking zone to go ahead. A second letter was considered, if people don't want a parking zone, then they could relook at what they would like, The action group is going to have further discussions. The next residence meeting is in June.

Red House Farm 2 Appeal has been submitted to the planning inspector.

Cllr Keen has been asked to set up a petition, Osbourne Court. County Cllr McKiernan said that she will raise the issue again with

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Richard Rayson. In the meantime if the parish council could carry out some assessments on who uses the crossing then the information would be useful.

Cllr Keen said that the crossing is not safe and SCC promised that the crossing would be changed as part of the transport agreement when Scientia Academy was built.

Cllr Burton asked if white lines along Longmead Road, Dover Road and Carlton Street could be explored to prevent cars being parked in some locations.
